(3) Review and Approval of minutes of November 20, 2025 Regular Meeting:

ACTION: A motion was made by Ryan Skrobarczyk to approve the minutes of the November 20, 2025 meeting. Jeff Edmonds seconded the motion.

(6) Motion to Approve the City of Corpus Christi's Well Applications:

DISCUSSION: To approve the well applications submitted by the City of Corpus Christi for 20 new wells located at the Eastern and Western Wellfields.

ACTION: A motion was made by Ryan Skrobarczyk to grant the permit applications submitted by the City of Corpus Christi with the following special conditions: 1. Develop a wellfield monitoring program within 60 days; 2. Develop a well operations plan that reduces possible negative impacts on adjacent existing water wells within 60 days; 3. Develop a monitoring program for land subsidence and provide a report annually to the District; 4. Develop a well assistance program through a Good Neighbor Program to

assist well owners; 5. Submit monthly water quality and pumping information; 6. Brief the District quarterly with well activity and compliance with the permits. Bill Mahaffey seconded the motion.

The Vote: All in Favor. The Applications were Approved

(7) Executive Session:

Executive Session pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.071 and Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct Rule 1.05 to consult with attorneys concerning legal issues related to rules and regulations of the CCASRCD, State of Texas, TCEQ, TWDB, other regulatory entities, and legal rights, property rights, and other legal matters related to well applications submitted to the Corpus Christi Aquifer Storage and Recovery Conservation District, including Art.
